These pictures *were taken by my brother* when we were in Italy last year.

6. We started our trip early because we wanted to avoid the heavy traffic

ORDER

We started our trip early in order to avoid the heavy traffic.

7. We need to buy the plane tickets now.

TIME

It is *high time we bought* the plane tickets.

8. The whole family went to say good-bye to grandma at the airport.

SEE

The whole family went *to see grandma off* at the airport.

9. It is possible that I forgot to pack my swimsuit

MIGHT

*I might have forgotten* to pack my swimsuit.

10. In the end, opening this motorway was a big success.

TURNED

Opening this motorway *turned out to be* a big success.

III.

1. They say travelling *broadens* the mind. (BROAD)

2. The host will greet the guests upon *arrival* at the hotel. (ARRIVE)

3. Cars must not park in front of the *entrance*. (ENTER)

4. The *departure* of the flight was delayed due to bad weather conditions. (DEPART)
